

## Wake County Public School System 100% Graduation Goal

“WCPSS students will demonstrate high academic growth by 2014; all students will graduate on time prepared to compete globally.”

To help measure the progress toward the goal, the district will look at more than 20 measures, including:

- \*Increasing the percentage of students proficient in the state’s math and reading end-of-grade exams in elementary and middle school;

- \*Increasing enrollment and proficiency in algebra I in middle school;

- \*Increasing the average SAT score; and

- \* Increasing the number of students enrolling in second languages courses in elementary, middle and high schools.
